JOB DESCRIPTION: SUMMER CAMP STAFF

Reporting to the Recreation Director, this position is responsible for ensuring a safe, enjoyable, and educational experience for children participating in our summer day camps. This is a full time, Monday to Friday, seasonal position during the months of July and August.

Key responsibilities

Supervision and Safety:

- Ensure the safety and well-being of all campers during activities, outings, and throughout the camp day.
- Implement and enforce safety protocols and emergency procedures.
- Supervise campers during lunch, breaks, and other free time to prevent accidents and ensure a positive environment.

Program Implementation:

- Plan, organize, and lead a variety of age-appropriate activities, including sports, arts and crafts, nature exploration, games, and team-building exercises.
- Develop and execute daily and weekly schedules, ensuring a balance of recreational, educational, and creative activities.

First Aid and Emergency Response:

- Be trained in Emergency First Aid and CPR Level C to respond quickly and appropriately to any medical emergencies.
- Administer basic first aid as needed and coordinate with medical professionals when necessary.

Role Modeling:

- Demonstrate enthusiasm, a positive attitude, and a strong work ethic.
- Uphold and enforce camp policies and rules.

Adaptability:

- Be flexible and adaptable to changes in schedule, activities, or unexpected situations.
